Before You Enter

Spectator Entry

To allow participants time to rehearse, spectators cannot enter the arena immediately.
When it is time for your session:
Leave the Vendor Village via the main entrance.
Walk around the building via St Cyprian's Path.
Enter through the Ivy Road Spectator Entrance (clearly signposted).
