BY CAR

The K2 is situated just off the M23 (near Gatwick Airport)
Easily accessible from the M25



BY TRAIN

Regular trains from London to Crawley. The K2 is a 5min taxi or 30min stroll
from Crawley Train Station

TIME AFTER THE COMP?



Tilgate Park is situated next to the K2 Arena. If you have time after your session and the sun is shining, Tilgate Park is super fun for the kids with a huge playground, Go Ape, a lake, and the Smith and Western restaurant.

ON COMP DAY

Prior to Comp day (when confirmed by the competition event providers), CLA management will post the following in your Team WhatsApp group. This has ALL your timings for the day.

MEET TIME



The time you will meet at the entrance to the K2 Arena

CHECK IN TIME



The time your child will be collected from the seating area to go to warm up (keep an eye out for your teams coach and a HUGE wave)

SHOW TIME



the time your child and their team will be on the mat competing (YAY!)

AWARDS TIME



The time the awards ceremony takes place.

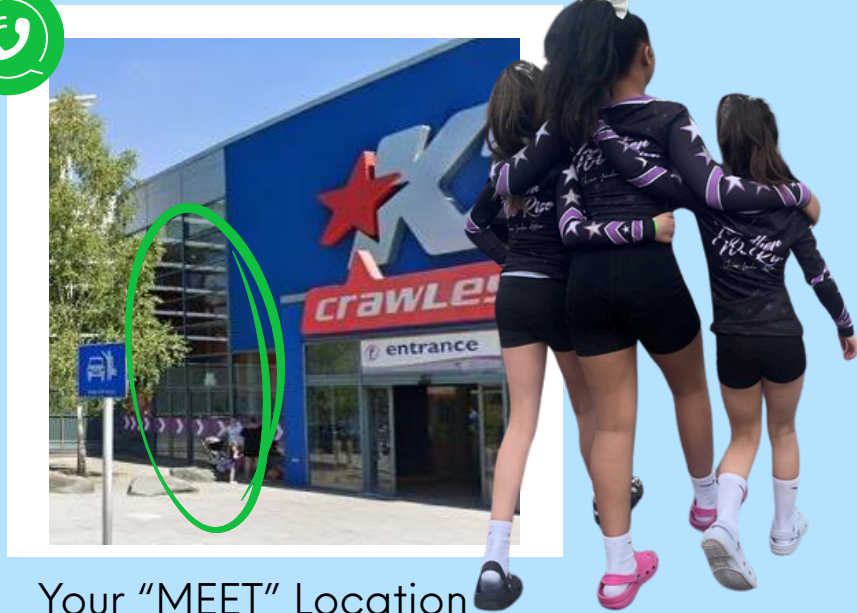
FINISH TIME



Home Time! You are all done and dusted!

ON COMP DAY... JUST BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Your Competition Lead (CLA Staff member) will post a photo in your Team Whatsapp Group for your arrival meet point.
(not the exact ones below but so you get the idea)



Your "MEET" Location

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



All children competing will receive a wristband. This must go on the LEFT wrist and NEVER be taken off. If taken off, your child will not be allowed to enter, as the competition providers have a strict (No WRISTBAND NO ENTRY POLICY). Spectators will also receive a wristband.

Please wear it and do not take it off.

If you are attending a TWO-day competition,

DO NOT TAKE IT OFF OVERNIGHT! THEY MUST STAY ON.

SPECTATOR TICKETS

Every child competing has 1x included spectator ticket.

Those who have previously purchased Spectator tickets will collect theirs from Lily upon arrival. A reminder list will be posted in your Team Group on Saturday 11 th April (Wristband for spectators also)

AFTER PERFORMING THE TEAM WILL GO TO VIDEO PLAYBACK



RETURN TO SEATING AREA FOR CHILDREN TO BE RETURNED TO PARENTS



ENJOY THE COMPETITION, EXPLORE THE MERCHANDISE AND PICTURES, AND RETURN TO YOUR SEATED AREA 5 MINUTES PRIOR TO AWARDS TIME. CLA STAFF WILL TAKE CHILDREN TO THE MAT FOR AWARDS. PLEASE REMAIN IN THE SEATING AREA READY FOR CHILDREN TO BE RETURNED TO YOU AFTER THE AWARDS.

IF YOU KNOW, YOU KNOW

The POSITIVITY PEG Tradition is HUGE at Cheer Comps! If it's your first Comp, be prepared to be clipped by random Pegs throughout the day!

WHAT ON EARTH, TELL ME MORE

Cheer Teams and Athletes decorate their own pegs and take them to competitions (with CLA somewhere on their peg alongside words of inspiration). Children then swap and trade pegs at the competitions. It is a great way of making friends while sharing "Good Luck" Charms with other teams. Children often have a peg clipped to them without knowing as a sign of secret good luck! It's really cute, and we LOVE it! CLA Coaches seem to have pegs galore around their homes, collected over the years!
